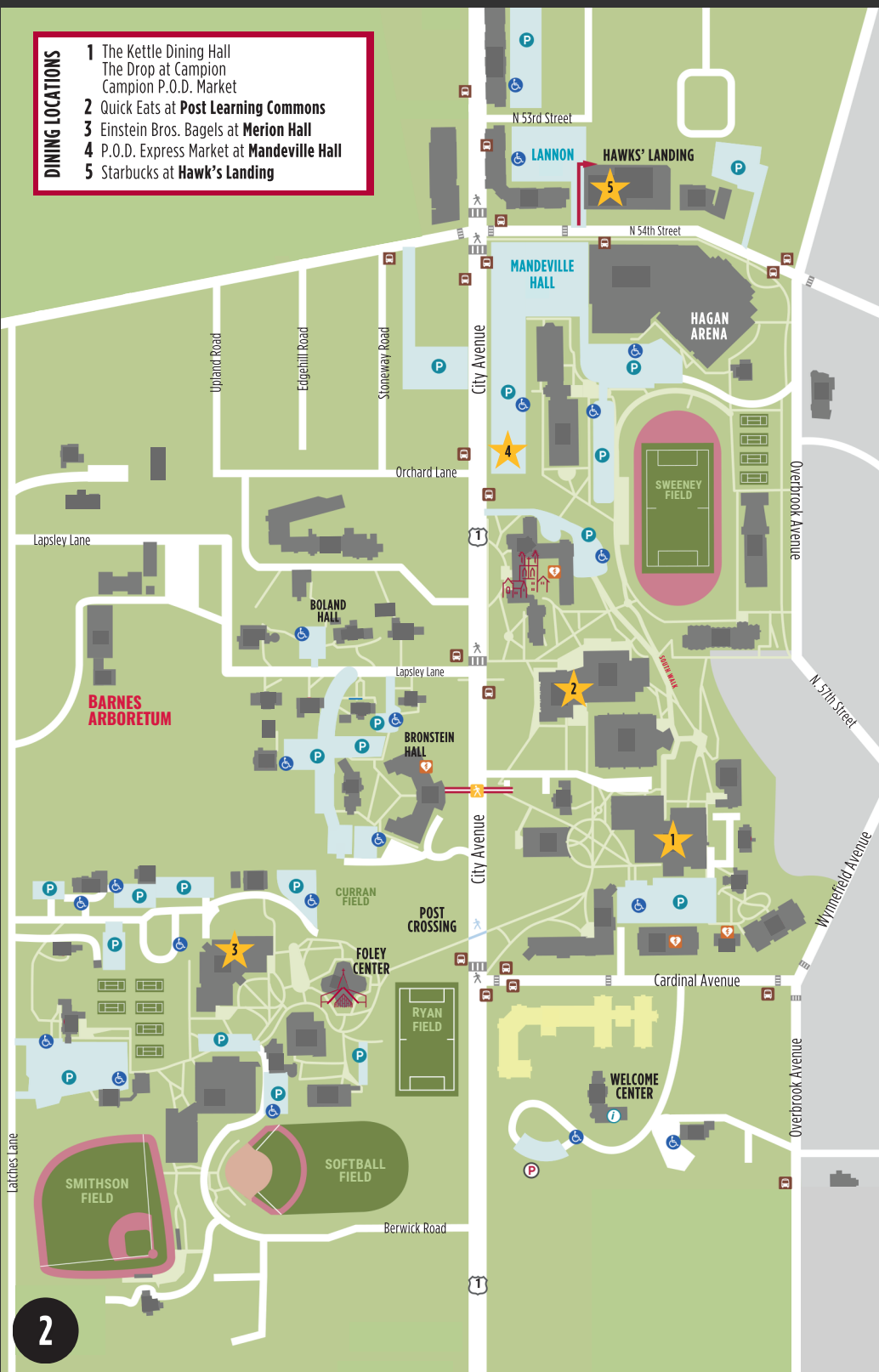

Starbucks at Hawk's Landing and **Einstein Bros. Bagels** in Merion Hall are two staples on campus that accept dining dollars.

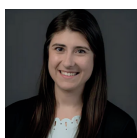

KEY POINTS & REMINDERS

All **First-Year Students** living on campus are required to have a dining plan. You will automatically be enrolled in the All-Access Plan at the start of the semester. You may upgrade to the All-Access Plus plan at anytime.



Download the App. Get the Transact Mobile Ordering App to access Hawk Eats, where you can place mobile orders using your Hawk Card at **The Drop**. Scan the QR code to download.

What is a Meal Exchange? A meal exchange *uses a meal swipe* to purchase a set of items at campus food venues beyond the dining hall.

Meal exchanges are NOT separate from meal swipes. If your plan has 25 Meal Swipes and 15 Meal Exchanges, 15 of your 25 Meal Swipes can be used as Meal Exchanges.
